COMMERCIAL ITEM DESCRIPTION
TRUCK, TILT, LIGHT-DUTY, MOBILE, PLASTIC

The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this commercial item description.

This commercial item description covers tilt trucks for materials handling, laundry, waste removal, and meat or poultry handling.

Salient characteristics:

- (1) Capacity - as specified; sizes are minimum.
 - (a) $1/2 \text{ yd}^3$, 300-lb load, two wheels - 8-inch diameter.
 - (b) 1 yd^3 , 750-lb load, two wheels - 10-inch diameter.
- (2) Shape - rectangular or square with slanted front.
- (3) Material - polyethylene. Tilt trucks shall meet USDA and FDA regulations for food handling.
- (4) Wheel and axle assembly - size as specified above, mounted at the edge of the base at the tilt-end.
- (5) Casters - minimum of one at the opposite edge of the wheel and axle assembly and centered or two evenly spaced along the edge.
- (6) Reinforced body and top rim.

Workmanship. Free from flash, blisters, cracks, chips, sharp fins, sharp edges, lumps and embedded foreign material, and seams.

Certification. The contractor shall certify that the product offered meets the salient characteristics of this description and that the product conforms to the producer's own drawings, specifications, standards, and quality assurance practices and is the same product offered for sale in the commercial marketplace. The Government reserves the right to require proof of such conformance prior to first delivery and thereafter as may be otherwise provided for under the provisions of the contract.

Recovered materials. The manufacturer shall utilize recovered materials to the maximum extent practicable.

Packaging, packing, and marking. Each tilt truck shall be packed to assure acceptance by common carrier and provide product protection against loss and damage during multiple shipments, handling, and storage. The shipping containers shall be in compliance with National Motor Freight Classification and Uniform Freight Classification. Marking shall be as specified in the contract or order.

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
