INSECTICIDE, NAPHTHALENE

1. SCOPE. This commercial item description (CID) covers naphthalene for use as a fumigant against fabric pests, primarily clothes moths. Naphthalene shall not be used in conjunction with paradichlorobenzene, which is also used as a fumigant against fabric pests.

2. CLASSIFICATION

Class A - Balls

Class B - Flakes

Class C - Chips

3. SALIENT CHARACTERISTICS

- 3.1 <u>Intended use</u>. The naphthalene shall be an effective fumigant against fabric eating pests and be registered as such with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
- 3.2 <u>Product concentration</u>. The product shall contain a minimum concentration of 99.0 percent naphthalene, by weight.
