- 1. This Commercial Item Description covers non-sulfonated neat's-foot oil.
- 2. Salient Characteristics:
- 2.1. The non-sulfonated neat's-foot oil shall be a clear liquid, free from sediment and admixture of other oils. The oil shall be free from rancidity and the odor shall not be objectionable. The oil shall conform to the requirements specified in table I.
