COMMERCIAL ITEM DESCRIPTION

BAG, PLASTIC, FOLDED GARMENT

The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this commercial item description.

1. Salient characteristics.

1.1 Design and construction. The plastic bag shall be of a reverse outside flap or a flap top construction. Bags may be flat or furnished with a bottom gusset that ranges between 1 and 4 inches. Seams shall be straight and continuous and shall have a minimum of 50 percent of the material strength. The reverse flap shall be a nominal 3 inches. Face and bottom panels shall be equal in dimensions. Bags may have a venting hole to permit excess air to escape.

1.2 Material. The plastic bags shall be fabricated from clear polyolefin material conforming to L-P-378. The material thickness shall exceed 1-mil, except when the face of the bag exceeds 130 square inches, the material shall have a minimum thickness of 3 mil.

1.3 Fit and size. The plastic bag shall fit the folded garment by not exceeding any dimension or combination of dimensions by more than 10 percent of the garment's dimensions when folded.

1.4 Closure. When the plastic bags are filled and closed, the closure shall be secure and without distortion. When the face width of a bag exceeds 14 inches, a piece of pressure adhesive tape shall be placed across the center of the closure to add security to the closure.

2. Certification. The contractor shall certify that the product offered meets the salient characteristics of this description, conforms to the producers' own drawing, specification, standard, and quality assurance practices and is the same product sold in the commercial marketplace, except for the additional requirements/characteristics specified herein. The Government reserves the right to require proof of such conformance prior to first delivery and thereafter as may be otherwise provided for under the provisions of the contract.

Packing and palletization. When procured by the Government, one thousand bags be packed in a snug-fitting fiberboard shipping container that conforms to 636. The shipping container shall be completely filled with no voids and of a hat can be palletized in accordance with MIL-STD-147. Each shipping container be closed in accordance with the appendix of PPP-P-636. When specified (see plastic bags, packed as specified, shall be palletized in accordance with MIL-7.

Marking. For Government procurements only, and in addition to any special g required by the contract or purchase order, shipping containers and ized unit loads shall be marked in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

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Intended use. The plastic bags are intended for use as a protective unit pack rious clothing items.
