COMMERCIAL ITEM DESCRIPTION

HEATING ELEMENT, ELECTRICAL (REPLACEMENTS FOR DOMESTIC APPLIANCES)

This Commercial Item Description (CID) is approved by the Commissioner, Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration, for the use of all Federal agencies.

Abstract. The electrical heating element is intended to be used as a replacement item for domestic water heaters, ranges, dishwashers, dryers, and hot plates.

Salient characteristics. The heating element shall meet UL 1030 requirements. As applicable to each appliance, the electrical characteristics (voltage, phase, kilowatt rating), the type of sheath and coil material, size, shape, and performance of the replacement element, including any integral component (such as mounting, terminal block, built-in thermostat, etc.), shall be the same or better as the original element that is to be replaced. The replacement element shall match and fit exactly into the appliance without requiring any field modification in the element nor at the appliance.

Contractor certification. The contractor shall certify and maintain substantiating evidence that the product offered meets the salient characteristics of this CID and that the product conforms to the producer's own drawings, specifications, standards, and quality assurance practices. The Government reserves the right to require proof of such conformance prior to first delivery and thereafter as may be otherwise provided for under the provisions of the contract.
