COMMERCIAL ITEM DESCRIPTION

TUBING, NONMETALIC (Rubber)

The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this commercial item description as a replacement for military specification MIL-T-36966 which has been canceled.

This commercial item description covers two sizes of latex rubber tubing suitable for laboratory use.

Salient characteristics.

The tubing shall be fabricated of natural rubber latex without any added coloration. The tubing shall be of uniform cross-section and free from porosity. The inside and outside surfaces shall be smooth and free of powder, dust, oil, grease, dirt, fins and any foreign matter or surface defect which impair its serviceability. The tubing shall have a tensile strength of at least 1200 p.s.i. and an ultimate elongation of at least 750 percent. The tubing shall be of the following sizes and dimensions.

1/8	1/8 inch	1/32 inch	+ 1/128 inch
3/16	3/16 inch	3/32 inch	+ 1/64 inch

Workmanship. The tubing shall be free from defects which detract from its appearance or impair its serviceability.

Unit. Foot (FT). One linear foot of tubing, as specified, constitutes one unit.

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Metric products. Products manufactured to metric dimensions will be considered on an equal basis with those manufactured using inch-pound units, providing they fall within the tolerances specified using conversion tables contained in the latest revision of Federal Standard 376, and all other requirements of this document are met. If a product is manufactured to metric dimensions and those dimensions exceed the tolerances specified in the inch-pound units, a request should be made to the contracting officer to determine if the product is acceptable. The contracting officer has the option of accepting or rejecting the product.

Contractor certification. The contractor shall certify that the product offered meets the salient characteristics of this description and conforms to the producers' own drawings, specifications, standards, and quality assurance practices. The Government reserves the right to require proof of such conformance prior to first delivery and thereafter as may be otherwise provided for under the provisions of the contract.

Regulatory requirements.

Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act. If the product covered by this document has been determined by the U. S. Food and Drug Administration to be under its jurisdiction, the offeror/contractor shall comply, and be responsible for compliance by its subcontractors/suppliers, with the requirements of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, as amended, and regulations promulgated thereunder. In addition, the offeror/contractor shall comply, and be responsible for compliance by its subcontractor/suppliers, with the requirements of all other applicable Federal, State and local statutes, ordinances, and regulations.

Recovered materials. The offeror/contractor is encouraged to use recovered material in accordance with Public Law 94-580, as amended, and as implemented by Federal Acquisition Regulation Subpart 23.4 to the maximum extent practical.

Preservation, packaging, packing, labeling, and marking. Unless otherwise specified, preservation, packaging, and packing shall be to a degree of protection to preclude damage to containers and/or contents thereof under normal shipping conditions, handling, etc., involving shipment from the supply source to the receiving activity, plus reshipment from receiving activity, and shall conform to applicable carrier's rules and regulations. Intermediate and exterior package quantities and labeling and marking shall be as specified in the contract and/or order.
