COMMERCIAL ITEM DESCRIPTION

ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL, USP

The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this Commercial Item Description as a replacement for Military Specification MIL-I-37443 which is cancelled.

Salient characteristics.

Shall be Isopropyl Alcohol, USP.

Shall be in accordance with the requirements of the USP.

All ingredients shall be of a pharmaceutical grade.

Workmanship. The alcohol shall be free from defects which detract from its appearance or impair its serviceability.

Unit.

For Size 1 - Bottle (BT). One bottle containing 16 fl. oz. (473 ml), as specified, constitutes one unit.

For Size 2 - Can (CN). One metal can containing 32 fl. oz. (946 ml), as specified, constitutes one unit.

For Size 3 - Drum (DR).

For the Department of Defense, one plastic drum containing 5 gal (18.9 liters), as specified, constitutes one unit. Drum shall be equipped with a faucet or spout to facilitate removal of contents.

For the Department of Veterans Affairs, one metal drum containing 5 gal (18.9 liters), as specified, constitutes one unit.

For Size 4 - Drum (DR). One plastic drum containing 54 gallons (204.4 liters), as specified, constitutes one unit.

Unless otherwise specified, preservation, packaging, and packing shall be to the degree of protection to preclude damage to containers and/or contents thereof under normal shipping conditions, handling, etc., involving shipment from the supply source to receiving activity, plus reshipment from receiving activity, and shall conform to applicable carrier's rules and regulations. Intermediate and exterior package quantities and labeling and marking shall be as specified in the contract and/or order.
