The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this commercial item description for all federal agencies.

1. **SCOPE.** This commercial item description (CID) covers analytical chemicals.
2. **SALIENT CHARACTERISTICS.** Unless otherwise specified, analytical chemicals required in tests and assays should conform either to the specifications of the "Reagent Chemicals: American Chemical Society Specifications," or the requirements contained in the "Reagents, Indicators, and Solutions" portion of the non-monographed section of "The United States Pharmacopoeia and the National Formulary."
3. **REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS**
  - 3.1 Marking, packaging, and labeling. Material shall be labeled, packed, and marked in accordance with Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) sections 100 to 185.
  - 3.2 Recycled materials. The offeror/contractor is encouraged to use recovered materials to the maximum extent practical, in accordance with 23.403 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR).
  - 3.3 Material safety data sheet (MSDS). The manufacturer shall comply with requirements set forth by the Hazardous Communication Standard 29 CFR, paragraph 1910.1200 (d) through (g).
