### Use/Relationship:

The Contractual Shipping Documentation DID will provide the Government with the information needed to help the Item Management inspect and manage the program.

### Requirements:

1. Format. The Contractual Shipping Documentation shall be in the Contractor's format.

2. Content. The Contractual Shipping Documentation shall contain and identify:

- a) Ship name and hull number
- b) List of applicable Schedule "A" numbers, nomenclature and quantity.
- c) National Stock Numbers
- d) Serial and Part Numbers.
- e) A complete inventory of all GFE provided at a level of detail that includes discrete individual cabinets, components, interface devices, kits and other individually packaged items.
- f) List of all applicable Engineering Change Proposals (ECP) changes.
- g) Itemized list of all Shipped Short items at the Schedule "A" level along with the estimated delivery dates.
- h) Disposition instructions for any material that the shipyard is expected to return, such as shipping reels or containers.

3. The Contractual Shipping Documentation shall also include:

- a) Government Bill of Lading (GBL) Number.

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- b) Carrier Name and assigned Tracking Number (Pro-number) and phone number.
- c) Date the GFE was shipped and estimated arrival date to the shipyard for each shipment.
- d) All loose parts and the contents of each kit shall be listed in detail to show accurate inventory at the shipyard receiving warehouse.
