3.3 Content. As a minimum, the supplier shall have in place a compliant Non-Destructive Testing program in accordance with ASNT TC-1A. Accordingly, specific objective evidence shall be provided to demonstrate compliance.

3.3.1 NDT Training Program Written Practice: The supplier shall have a documented written practice for his/her Non-destructive Testing activities in accordance with ASNT-TC-1A. The supplier shall provide evidence that the training program is properly established by way of submitting a copy of the program or making reference to the same via a statement of compliance including, if applicable, where the program exists within their quality program and/or operating procedures (i.e. excerpt from a Table of Contents; cover page of the program document, reference to a procedure number, etc).

3.3.2 Level III Examiner: When NAVSEA S9074-AQ-GIB-010/248 is specified, the supplier shall have under their employ a Level III examiner available to approve the Welding Training program. If a Level III examiner is not directly employed by the supplier, the use of an

accredited sub-contractor is permissible. The supplier shall provide evidence that this requirement has been met by providing a copy of the Level III examiner's credentials.
