- a. This Data Item Description (DID) contains the format and content preparation instructions for a Drawing Number Assignment Report resulting from the work task described by 3.7.2 of MIL-DTL-31000C.
- b. This DID may be applied whenever Government drawing numbers are allocated to a contractor for drawing identification.
- c. This DID supersedes DI-SESS-81011B, which superseded D1-DRPR-81011A.

## Requirements:

- a. Reference Documents. The applicable issue of documents cited herein, including their approval dates and the dates of applicable amendments, notices, and revisions, shall be as cited in the contract.
2. General The Drawing Number Assignment Report shall meet the requirements of MIL-DTL-31000C.
3. Format. The report shall be in the contractor's format.
4. Content. The report shall list all Government drawing numbers used or allocated under the contract in numerical sequence and identify the following for each number, as applicable:
  - a. Government drawing number.
  - b. Drawing size.
  - c. Drawing title.
  - d. End item designation (e.g. weapon system) on which the drawing is used.
  - e. Whether the drawing number represents an existing drawing number, an assigned drawing number, or an unused drawing number.

4.1. The report shall include the contractor's name and address and the Government (prime) contract number for which the report is required.

5. Definitions. For the purposes of identifying drawing numbers as required in 4.e above, the following definitions apply:

- a. Existing drawing number - A drawing number identifying a drawing which was prepared outside the scope of the contract for which the report is required.
- b. Assigned drawing number - A drawing number identifying a drawing prepared under the contract for which the report is required. It is a number allocated under the contract and used to identify a drawing.
- c. Unused drawing number - A drawing number allocated under the contract but not used to identify a drawing.
