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- (3) Instructions for preventive and corrective maintenance, troubleshooting, repair, test alignment, and calibration procedures.
- (4) Parts information sufficient to identify and order (from commercial or Government supply sources) failed parts.
- (5) Software or firmware descriptions, where required, either through coverage or references to documents that contain pertinent information.
- (6) A description of the installation.

  - g. Price and availability of the date and the quantity required.
