FEDERAL STANDARD

TOWELS (BATH, DISH, GLASS AND HAND)

Authority. This standard is issued pursuant to the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended, and its application to the purchase of commodities referred to herein is mandatory on all Federal agencies.

S1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This standard implements the results of an item reduction study, and establishes two types and three styles of Towel, Bath, two types of Towel or Dishcloth, one type of Towel, Glass, one type and three classes of Towel, Hand, in various sizes and colors. They are recommended for use by all Federal agencies to achieve the highest practical degree of standardization.

S2. APPLICATION

Purchases under the Federal Specifications listed above shall be limited to items having characteristics conforming to the standard items specified herein. Existing Government stocks of items with other characteristics shall continue to be utilized until exhausted.
