FEDERAL STANDARD

FAN, CIRCULATING, RADIAL DISCHARGE

This standard was approved by the Commissioner,  
Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration,  
for the use of all Federal agencies.

S1. Purpose and scope. This standard establishes one size radial discharge-type fan (hassock) and adopts it as a standard item for use of all Federal agencies to achieve the highest practical degree of standardization.

S2. Application. Purchases from commercial sources under Federal Specification W-F-95, of the issue in effect on the date of invitation for bids, shall be limited to items which have characteristics conforming to the standard item specified herein. Existing Government stocks of items with other characteristics shall continue to be utilized until exhausted. In those cases where this Federal Standard eliminates supply items and the items so eliminated are under contract, if the contract cannot be negotiated or amended to conform to the standard items, the Federal Standard becomes mandatory at the contract expiration date.

S3. Standard characteristics and item identification. The item described in the following Federal Stock Number is the standard radial discharge fan covered by this Federal Standard:

NSN 4140-00-203-3807 - 12 inch blade

S4. Changes. Recommendations for addition or deletion of items must be supported by detailed justification and submitted in duplicate to the General Services Administration, Federal Supply Service, Mechanical and Electrical Division, Washington, DC 20406. After evaluation, the initiator will be notified of the action taken.

S5. Conflict with referenced specifications. Where the requirements specified in this standard conflict with any requirements in a referenced specification, the requirements of the standard shall apply. The nature of the conflict between the standard and the referenced specification shall be submitted, in duplicate, to General Services Administration, Federal Supply Services, Mechanical and Electrical Division, Washington, DC 20406.
