INTERIM AMENDMENT
TO
FEDERAL SPECIFICATION
PAPER, ASBESTOS

This interim amendment was developed by the General Services Administration, Federal Supply Service, Washington, DC 20406, based upon currently available technical information. It is recommended that Federal agencies use it in procurement and forward recommendations for changes to the preparing activity at the address shown above.

The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this interim amendment as a valid exception to Federal Specification HH-P-1784 dated April 19, 1973.

PAGE 4

Delete paragraph 4.3.1 entirely.

PAGE 5

Paragraph 4.5.2, delete: Formula for calculating the percent of asbestos fiber content of the paper and substitute the following:

$$\frac{\text{grams of ash X 100}}{0.86} = \text{percent asbestos fiber}$$

Add paragraph 4.7 as follows:

4.7 CERTIFICATION: A certificate of compliance shall be acceptable as proof that the product being offered meets the requirements of paragraphs 3.2, 3.3, and 3.4, provided the contractor furnishes actual test results, acceptable to the Government, indicating that tests have been performed to substantiate the certification. The certificate shall state

that the tests described in paragraphs 4.5.2, 4.5.3, and 4.5.4 have been performed on products manufactured from the same material and manufacturing process of the items being offered and that any proposed changes in material or process will be promptly reported to the Government. The Government reserves the right to require additional testing and certification by the contractor when such changes are made or when otherwise deemed necessary.
