LEATHER, KIDSKIN OR GOATSKIN, CHROME TANNED

This amendment, which forms part of Federal Specification KK-L-170C, dated February 11, 1972, was approved by the Commissioner, Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration, for the use of all Federal agencies.

3.2.6, line 4. Delete "9.0" and substitute "8.5".

3.2.7, line 3. Insert "expanded" before "AATCC".

3.2.10 In line 4. Delete "at or". In line 5. Delete "a test failure" and substitute "reported as a failing specimen."

PAGE 6

4.3 Delete subparagraph "a" and substitute the following:

"a. More than 3 specimens fail to meet stitch tearing strength requirements or more than 3 specimens fail to meet elongation requirements."

PAGE 7

4.4.1, after title. Delete paragraph and substitute the following:

"Method 3202 of FED-STD-311 shall be used except that the grain surface of the folded specimen shall be rubbed together under moderate pressure for 30 seconds."
