INTERIM AMENDMENT

TO

FEDERAL SPECIFICATION

PAINT, VARNISH, LACQUER, AND RELATED MATERIALS;  
PACKAGING, PACKING AND MARKING OF

This interim amendment was developed by the General Services Administration, Federal Supply Service, Washington, DC 20406, based upon currently available technical information. It is recommended that Federal agencies use it in procurement and forward recommendations for changes to the preparing activity at the address shown above.

The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this interim amendment as a valid exception to Federal Specification PPP-P-1892, dated December 31, 1974.

"3.11.5 Coatings containing lead. All containers with coating materials which contain lead compounds in excess of 0.06 percent by weight (calculated as lead metal) in the total nonvolatile content shall be marked with the following warning notices:

"WARNING"  
"CONTAINS LEAD. DRIED FILM OF THIS PAINT  
MAY BE HARMFUL IF EATEN OR CHEWED."

"Do not apply on toys and other children's articles, furniture, or interior surfaces of any dwelling or facility which may be occupied or used by children.

"Do not apply on those exterior surfaces of dwelling units, such as window sills, porches, stairs, or railings to which children may be commonly exposed.

"Keep out of reach of children."
