INTERIM AMENDMENT
TO
FEDERAL SPECIFICATION

BOXES, FIBERBOARD, CORRUGATED, TRIPLE-WALL

This interim amendment was developed by Navy Ships Parts Control Center, Mechanicsburg, PA 17055-0788, based upon currently available technical information. It is recommended that Federal agencies use it in procurement and forward recommendations for changes to the preparing activity at the address shown above.

The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this interim amendment as a valid exception to PPP-B-640, dated July 29, 1966.

PAGE 1

1.2.1: Add the following class:

- "3 - Nonweather resistant/fire retardant.
- 4 - Weather-resistant/fire retardant."

PAGE 2

3.1.2: Add "The facings and corrugating media shall be made from virgin and reclaimed fibers having such qualities that the fiberboard will comply with the requirements of this specification. Fiberboard used in the construction of class 3 boxes shall meet the fire retardant requirements of PPP-F-320."

PAGE 3

3.1.3.1, line 1, after "class 1": Add "and class 3".

3.1.3.2, line 1, after "class 2": Add "and class 4".

3.8.1, line 16: Delete "flap" and substitute "overlap".
Line 17: Delete "flap" and substitute "overlap".
Line 28: Delete "flap" and substitute "overlap".
Line 34: Delete "flap" and substitute "overlap".

3.10.1.1.4, line 3, after "class 1": Add "and 3".

PAGE 7

3.12.1 (cont'd), line 3, after "as follows": Add the following: "For class 3 and 4 boxes, the words "FIRE RETARDANT" shall marked below the specification number."

In the last line: Delete "Class 1 or 2" and substitute "Class 1, 2, 3, or 4".

Add the following paragraph:

3.15, Additional Requirements. The supplier must certify that the product supplied contains at least 40% post consumer recovered material.

4.6.5, in fourth to last line on page: Delete 15 ± 5 " and substitute 25 ± 5 ".

PAGE 12

4.6.6, line 1, after "class 2": Add "add class 4".

PAGE 13

6. NOTES Add the following:

"6.1.3 Class 3 use. Boxes are for shipments and storage involving extreme climatic conditions but where fire retardant fiberboard is desired. Fire retardant fiberboard is intended to reduce the risks and hazards of fire aboard Navy ships and to improve fleet readiness losses due to fire destruction in compliance with the Navy Passive Fire Protection Program."

"6.1.4 Class 4 use. Boxes are for shipments and storage involving extreme climatic conditions and when exposure to high humidities is contemplated. Fire retardant fiberboard is intended to reduce the risks and hazards of fire aboard Navy ships and to improve fleet readiness by reducing losses due to fire destruction in compliance with the Navy Passive Fire Protection Program."
