FEDERAL SPECIFICATION

AGGREGATE: (FOR) PORTLAND-CEMENT-CONCRETE

This amendment which forms a part of Federal Specification SS-A-281b dated July 8, 1954, was approved by the Commissioner, Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration, for the use of all Federal agencies.

Page 5, paragraph 3.2.5: Delete in its entirety and substitute new paragraph 3.2.5 as follows:

3.2.5 Weight of slag.—Blast-furnace slag conforming to the grading to be used in the concrete shall have a compact weight of not less than 70 pounds per cubic foot.

Page 6, following paragraph 6.5, insert the following:

Patent notice.—When Government drawings, specifications, or other data are used for any purpose other than in connection with a definitely related Government procurement operation, the United States Gov-

ernment thereby incurs no responsibility nor any obligation whatsoever; and the fact that the Government may have formulated, furnished, or in any way supplied the said drawings, specifications, or other data, is not to be regarded by implication or otherwise as in any manner licensing the holder or any other person or corporation, or conveying any rights or permission to manufacture, use or sell any patented invention that may in any way be related thereto.

Page 6, Section 7 — Delete "Interested Activities" and substitute:

"INTERESTED ACTIVITIES:
Army—E
Navy—Y S MC
Air Force."
