INTERIM AMENDMENT
TO
FEDERAL SPECIFICATION
LACQUER, CAMOUFLAGE

This interim amendment was developed by the Army Materials and Mechanics Research Center, AMQMR-LS, Watertown, Massachusetts 02172, based upon currently available technical information. It is recommended that Federal agencies use it in procurement and forward recommendations for changes to the preparing activity at the address shown above. The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this interim amendment as a valid exception to Federal Specification TT-L-20A, dated April 25, 1967.

PAGE 1

After paragraph 1.2.1 insert the following:

"1.2.1.1 The list of colors in table II is not restrictive. The lacquer may be procured in any color desired by the activity concerned. When colors other than those of table II are required, the pigmentation and applicable qualitative and quantitative requirements shall conform to those of the nearest matching color contained in the table. Where no near matching color exists, the ingredients shall be in accordance with the best commercial quality."
