FEDERAL SPECIFICATION

PUTTY; PURE-LINSEED-OIL (FOR) WOOD-SASH-GLAZING

This amendment, which forms a part of Federal Specification TT-P-791a, dated June 25, 1988, was approved by the Commissioner, Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration, for the use of all Federal agencies.

Paragraph 3: Delete the entire paragraph and substitute Method 7301 of Fed. Test Method Std. No. 141.

Paragraph F-4d: Delete the entire paragraph.

Paragraph F-4e: Delete the entire paragraph.

Page 8:

Paragraph F-4f: Delete the entire paragraph.

Paragraph F-4g: Delete the entire paragraph.

Section G, paragraphs G-1, G-2, and G-3: Delete in their entirety and substitute the following:

G. PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY

(For civil agency procurement, the definitions and applications of the levels of packaging and packing shall be in accordance with Fed. Std. No. 102.)

G-1 Packaging.

G-1a Level A. The product shall be packaged in one-pint, one-quart, or one-gallon quantities, as specified (see I-5) in containers conforming to PPP-C-96, type V, class 2.

G-1b Level C. The product shall be packaged in accordance with the manufacturers standard commercial practice.

G-2 Packing shall be level A, B, or C, as specified (see I-5).

G-2a Level A. The product shall be packed in accordance with the appendix to PPP-C-96, as specified for overseas shipment.

G-2b Level B. The product shall be packed in accordance with the appendix to PPP-C-96, as specified for domestic shipment.

G-2c Level C. The product shall be packed to insure carrier acceptance and safe delivery to destination in containers

complying with the rules and regulations applicable to the mode of transportation.

G-3 Marking.

G-3a Civil agencies. In addition to markings specified in the contract or order, the packages and shipping containers shall be marked in accordance with Fed. Std. No. 123.

G-3b Military activities. In addition to markings specified in the contract or order, the packages and shipping containers shall be marked in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

Section H, paragraphs H-1, H-1a, H-1b,

H-1c, H-2, H-2a, H-2a(1), H-2a(2)a, H-2a(2)b: Delete in entirety.

Section I, paragraph 1-2a, line 4: Delete "TT-P-36" and substitute "TT-P-102a."

Page 10, paragraph I-5: Delete and substitute the following:

I-5 The units of issue for putty shall be as follows:

1 pint can (approximately 2 lbs.)

1 quart can (approximately 4 lbs.)

1 gallon can (approximately 16 lbs.).
