FEDERAL SPECIFICATION

SEALING COMPOUND, SYNTHETIC-
RUBBER BASE, SINGLE COMPONENT
CHEMICALLY CURING (FOR CALKING,
AND GLAZING IN BUILDING
CONSTRUCTION)

This amendment, which forms a part of Federal specification TT-S-230a, dated May 5, 1967, was approved by the Commissioner, Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration, for the use of all Federal agencies.

PAGE 1

Title: Delete "(FOR CALKING, AND GLAZING IN BUILDING CONSTRUCTION) " and substitute "(FOR CALKING, SEALING, AND GLAZING IN BUILDING CONSTRUCTION)."

PAGE 3

Paragraph 3.6, line 2: Delete "shall be less than 10 lbs." and substitute "shall be not less than 10 lbs."

PAGE 4

Paragraph 4.3.2.1, line 6: After "air dried" add "4a/."

At batten of page add the following footnote:

"4a/ Methyl ethyl ketone end similar cleaning solvents are bath toxic and flammable and should be handled with caution in a well-ventilated hood. "

PAGE 5

Footnote "5/", line 5: Delete "violet radiation" and substitute "ultraviolet radiation".

PAGE 8

Paragraph 4.3.10, line 1: Delete "Two plate peel" and substitute "Two plate glass peel".

PAGE 15

Turn figure 5 around 180° for proper interpretation of the legend.
