Delete footnote "3/" below table and substitute:

"3/ The color transfer cloth evaluation shall not apply. No appreciable change in shade or loss of color of the tested specimen shall be visible when compared to the untested thread retained."

PAGE 9

4.2.4.1.1, last line, after "match": Add "period", and delete remainder of sentence.

Add the following new paragraph:

;

"4.2.4.1.2 <u>Shade matching procedure</u>. The gimp thread sample shall be wound or prepared for examination in a manner similar to that for the standard shade sample. The gimp sample shall be compared to the standard sample under artificial daylight at 7000 + 500 K, and less than a good match shall be a test failure. The gimp sample shall also be compared to the standard sample under incandescent lamplight at 2850 + 100 K, and less than a good approximation shall be a test failure.
