INTERIM AMENDMENT
 TO
 FEDERAL SPECIFICATION

SOLDERING IRON, ELECTRIC

This interim amendment was developed by Standardization Division, Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration, Washington, D. C. 20406, based upon currently available technical information. It is recommended that Federal agencies use it in procurement and forward recommendations for changes to the preparing activity at the address shown above.

The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this interim amendment as a valid exception to Federal Specification W-S-570a, dated April 21, 1961, and Amendment-2, dated May 14, 1962.

Paragraph 3.6: Delete and substitute:

3.6 Component parts. Each complete soldering iron shall consist essentially of one tip, one heating unit, one handle, 4-1/2-foot minimum length cord, and one plug connector.

PAGE 4

Add at bottom of table I, all columns, to provide for larger iron as follows:

Add footnote 2 below table I as follows:

²The diameter (dimension C) shall be considered the dimension across corners of noncircular shell assembly shapes."
