FEDERAL SPECIFICATION

TUBE, COPPER; SEAMLESS (FOR AIR CONDITIONING AND REFRIGERATION)

This specification was approved by the Commissioner, Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration, for the use of all Federal agencies.

1. SCOPE AND CLASSIFICATION

- 1.1 Scope. This specification covers seamless copper tube suitable for use with solder-type or flared-tube fittings. The actual outside diameter is the same as the nominal size.
- 1.2 Classification. Copper tubing shall be of the following types as specified (see 6.2).

Type I - Air conditioning tube.
Type II - Refrigeration service tube.

2. APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS

2.1 The following documents, of the issues in effect on date of invitation for bids or request for proposal, form a part of this specification to the extent specified herein.

3. REQUIREMENTS

3.1 General. Copper tubing furnished under this specification shall conform to ASTM B $280\,\cdot$

4. QUALITY ASSURANCE PROVISIONS

- 4.1 Responsibility for inspection. Unless otherwise specified in the contract or purchase order, the supplier is responsible for the performance of all inspection requirements as specified herein. Except as otherwise specified in the contract or order, the supplier may use his own or any other facilities suitable for the performance of the inspection requirements specified herein unless disapproved by the Government. The Government reserves the right to perform any of the inspections set forth in the specification where such inspections are deemed necessary to assure that supplies and services conform to prescribed requirements.
 - 4.2 Inspection. Inspect tubes in accordance with ASTM B 280.
- 4.3 Preparation for shipment. Examination of packing and marking for shipment shall be made to determine conformance with the requirements of section 5.

5. PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY

- 5.1 Packing. Packaging shall be level A, B, or C as specified (see 6.2).
- 5.1.1 Levels A and B. The material shall be separated by type, form, length, and size whenever practicable, and packed in accordance with MIL-C-3993.
- 5.1.2 Level C. Material shall be packed in containers which will insure acceptance by common carrier and safe delivery at destination. Containers shall be in accordance with Uniform Freight Classification or National Freight Classification as applicable.
- 5.2 Marking. Marking shall be in accordance with 5.2.1 or 5.2.2 as specified (see 6.2).
 - 5.2.1 Civil agencies. Marking shall be in accordance with Fed. Std. No. 123.
 - 5.2.2 Military agencies. Marking shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

6.1 Intended use. Tube covered by this specification is intended for use in air conditioning and refrigeration field service.
