4.2 (c) (2), delete "PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY" and substitute "PACKAGING".

PAGE 25

4.6.2, delete in its entirety and substitute "4.6.2 Inspection of packaging. Inspection of packaging shall be accomplished in accordance with the Quality Assurance provisions of MIL-B-55521."

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- * 4.7.6.2 Waterproofing of jackets (WOJ). delete in its entirety.

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5 thru 5.1, delete the entire section 5 and replace with the following paragraphs:

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"5. PACKAGING

5.1 Packaging requirements. Packaging requirements shall be in accordance with MIL-B-55521."

6.1(d), delete in its entirety.

6.1.1, first sentence, delete "packaging and marking".

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- * 6.4 International standardization agreements. Certain provisions of this specification are the subject of international standardization agreements. When amendment, revision, or cancellation of this specification is proposed which will modify the international agreement concerned, the preparing activity will take appropriate action through international standardization channels including departmental standardization offices to change the agreement or make other appropriate accommodations.
