AMENDMENT 1

25 August 1978

MILITARY SPECIFICATION

BELTS, AIRCRAFT SAFETY, LAP, TROOP, TYPES MD-1 AND MD-2

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-B-83787(USAF), dated 31 May 1972, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

PAGE 1

2.1: Under STANDARDS, Military add:

"MIL-STD-849 Inspection Requirements, Definitions And Classification Of Defects For Parachutes"

PAGE 2

3.4: Delete and substitute:

"3.4 Workmanship. The belt, including all parts and accessories shall conform to the quality established by this specification and documents referenced therein. Particular attention shall be given to freedom of parts from burrs and sharp edges. The occurrence of defects shall not exceed the acceptance criteria established herein. Repair of items is not allowed."

PAGE 3

Change "4.2.1.2" to "4.2.1.3" and add new 4.2.1.2 as follows:

"4.2.1.2 Visual and dimensional examination. Each belt assembly and component thereof shall be examined for conformance to MIL-STD-849. Belt assembly shall meet the requirements of personnel parachute harness in MIL-STD-849; however, repair of item in classification of defects table is not authorized."

PAGE 4

After 6.2 add: "6.3 Reclaimed materials. The use of reclaimed materials shall be encouraged to the maximum extent possible."
