## MILITARY SPECIFICATION

## CLEANING COMPOUND, DEGREASING AND DEPRESERVING SOLVENT

This amendment forms a part of MIL-C-11090F, dated 24 October 1991 and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

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Add as new paragraph 2.1.2:

\*2.1.2 Other Government documents, drawings, and publications:

40 CFR 433.11 Metal finishing point source category: specialized definitions

40 CFR 433.13 Metal finishing point source category: effluent limitations representing the degree of effluent reduction obtainable by applying the best practical control technology currently available."

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3.6: Add the following paragraph:

"The cleaning compound shall not contain any of the following chemicals: phenols, chromates, cyanide, or any other of the toxic organics listed in 40 CFR 433.11(e) or metals listed in 40 CFR 433.13(a). The following specific chemicals are also prohibited as components of the cleaning compound: 2-Methoxyethanol, 2-Ethoxyethanol, 2-Methoxyethyl Acetate, 2-Ethoxyethyl Acetate, 2-Butoxyethanol, 2-Phenoxyethanol, Ethylene Glycol Dimethyl Ether, Bis (2-Methoxyethyl) Ether, 2-(2-Ethoxyethoxy) Ethanol, 1-Methoxy-2-Propanol (or Propylene Glycol Monomethyl Ether), N-Butylamine, Monoethanolamine, Diethanolamine, Triethanolamine, Ethylenediamine, 2-Acetylaminofluorene, Aminodiphenyl, Aniline, Benzidine, 3, 3-Dichlorobenzidine, 4-Dimethylaminoazobenzene, 4-4-Methylenebis (2-Chloroaniline), Alpha-Naphthylamine, or Beta-Naphthylamine."
