

MIL-C-3369C (MU)  
AMENDMENT 1  
6 January 1967

MILITARY SPECIFICATION  
CARTRIDGE, CALIBER .30, CARBINE, BALL, M1

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-C-3369C (MU) dated 20 May 1966.

Paragraph 4.3.2.1, Under Table I: Change classification of defect No. 41, Weight, min. 2/ from "Major" to "Critical".

Footnote 2/ Delete and substitute:

"2/ Each lightweight cartridge shall be disassembled and the propellant weighed. Each such cartridge found to contain 7 grains or more of propellant shall be classed as a major defect. Any cartridge containing less than 7 grains of propellant shall be classed as a critical defect."

Paragraph 4.3.3.2, Under Table III, Defect No. 5, Add: Footnote mark "4".

To the footnotes of Table III, add:

"4/ Failures to extract shall be charged to ammunition whenever there is evidence of rim shear or rim chip."
