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5. Delete entire existing Section 5 and substitute:

"5. PACKAGING

5.1 Preservation, Packing, Unitization, and Marking - Commercial
Packaging (see 6.2).

5.1.1 Commercial. Preservation, packing, unitization, and marking shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-1188. Additional markings as may be required by the contract shall include date of manufacture (month and year).

NOTE: Military Packaging not applicable. Introduction into the supply system not anticipated."

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6.2.d, delete line d. and substitute:

"d. Packaging requirements if other than specified."
