## MILITARY SPECIFICATION

### CLOTH, AIRPLANE

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-C-5646F dated 30 August 1974 and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

#### PAGE 2

2.1, Delete: At the end of the paragraph:

"(Copies of specifications, standards, drawings, and publications required by supplier in connection with specific procurement functions should be obtained from the procuring activity or as directed by the contracting officer)."

Substitute:

"(Copies of specifications and standards required by contractors in connection with specific acquisition functions should be obtained from the contracting activity or as directed by the contracting officer)."

2.2, delete:

#### "American Society for Testing and Materials

ASTM-D377      Methods of Test for Small Amounts-of Copper and Manganese in Textiles.

(Application for copies should be addressed to the American Society for Testing and Materials, 1916 Race Street, Philadelphia, PA 19103)."

#### PAGE 3

Table I, delete maximum filling elongation of "11.0" and substitute "20.0."

#### PAGE 5

4.1, delete in its entirety and substitute:

"4.1 Responsibility for inspection. Unless otherwise specified in the contract or purchase order, the contractor is responsible for the performance of all inspection requirements as specified herein. Except as otherwise specified in the contract or purchase order, the contractor may use his own or any other facilities suitable for the performance of the inspection requirements specified herein, unless disapproved by the Government. The Government reserves the right to perform any of the inspections set forth in the specification where such inspections are deemed necessary to assure supplies and services conform to prescribed requirements."
