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5.3.1 Line 5, delete "NN-B-621, NN-B-631" and substitute "PPP-B-585, PPP-B-621".

5.3.2 Line 3, delete "JAN-P-106" and substitute "PPP-B-621".

Line 4, delete "Specification NN-P-515, Types I or II, Class 2" and substitute "NN-P-530, Group A, Type I or II, Grade 4. Plywood shall be surface treated in accordance with TT-W-732".

6.3 Provisions for Qualification Tests: Delete the entire paragraph and substitute "With respect to products requiring qualification, awards will be made only for such products as have, prior to the time set for opening of bids, been tested and approved for inclusion in the applicable Qualified Products List whether or not such products have actually been so listed by that date. The attention of the suppliers is called to this requirement, and manufacturers are urged to arrange to have the products that they propose to offer to the Federal Government tested for qualification in order that they may be eligible to be awarded contracts or orders for the products covered by this specification. The activity responsible for the Qualified Products List is the Naval Air Systems Command, Washington, D.C. 20360; however, information pertaining to qualification of products may be obtained from the Commanding Officer, Naval Ammunition Depot, Crane, Indiana 47522, Attention: Code 70531."
