MILITARY SPECIFICATION

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-C-60617(MJ) dated 3 February 1967.

Paragraph 4.3.3.2 Firing defects: Under Table III delete defect No. 1 and substitute the following:

Add the following note under Table III:

"6/ Each cartridge that misfires shall be disassembled and examined for presence of vent hole in primer pocket. If vent hole is missing, the lot shall be rejected with no second sample permitted."
