MILITARY SPECIFICATION

CORROSION PREVENTIVE COMPOUNDS, COLD-APPLICATION
(FOR NEW AND FIELDIED MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAILERS)

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-C-62218A, dated 16 October 1986, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

PAGE 4

3.2, line 6, delete "and 6.4".

Add the following paragraph:

"3.2.2 Recycled, virgin and reclaimed materials. There are no requirements for the exclusive use of virgin materials; however, all materials shall be new and unused. The use of recycled or reclaimed (recovered) materials is acceptable provided that all other requirements of this specification are met (see 6.4.1)."

PAGE 16

4.7.13.6.2, line 14, delete "500" and substitute "1000".

PAGE 18

5.1, delete the first sentence and substitute "Preservation, packaging, packing, and marking for the desired level shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-290 and the applicable packaging requirements specified by the contracting authority."

6.2k, delete and substitute:

"k. Selection of applicable level and packaging requirements (see 5.1)."

6.4, delete in its entirety and substitute:

"6.4 Definitions."

Add the following paragraphs:

"6.4.1 Recovered materials. 'Recovered materials' means materials that have been collected or recovered from solid waste (see 6.4.2).

6.4.2 Solid waste. 'Solid waste' means (a) any garbage, refuse, or sludge from a waste treatment plant, water supply treatment plant, or air pollution control facility; and (b) other discarded material, including solid, liquid, semisolid, or contained gaseous material resulting from industrial, commercial, mining, and agricultural operations, and from community activities. It does not include solid or dissolved material in domestic sewage, or solid or dissolved material in irrigation return flows or industrial discharges which are point sources subject to permits under section 402 of the Clean Water Act, (33 U.S.C. 1342 et seq.), or source, special nuclear, or byproduct material as defined by the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 (42 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.) (Source: Federal Acquisition Regulations, section 23.402)."
