PAGE 1

\*Add: "1.3 Part numbering. The part number shall be specified per AN or MS listed in supplement 1."

2.1: Under SPECIFICATIONS, Military;  
Add: "MIL-E-17555 Electronics and Electrical Equipment, Accessories, and Repair Parts; Packaging and Packing of".

Under STANDARDS, Military;  
Delete: "MIL-STD-100" and add "DOD-STD-100".

PAGE 2

\*Add: "3.3.2 Reclaimed materials. Reclaimed materials shall be used to the maximum extent possible without jeopardizing the intended end use of the item."

PAGE 4

\*3.6, line 3, delete "MIL-STD-100" and add "DOD-STD-100".

PAGE 7

Section 5: Delete "PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY IS NOT APPLICABLE TO THIS SPECIFICATION."

Add: "5.1 Preservation, packaging, packing and marking. Unless otherwise stipulated by the procuring activity, preservation packaging, packing, and marking shall be in accordance with the applicable requirements of MIL-E-17555, as specified (see 6.2)."

6.1a: Delete "Class covers." and substitute "Class A covers."

6.2 Add: "d. Selection of applicable levels of packaging and packing required (see 5.1)."
