MILITARY SPECIFICATION

COATING, EPOXY, FOR STEEL STRUCTURES

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-C-82407(CG) dated 23 July 1968.

Page 2, paragraph 3.2: Delete and substitute: "3.2 Color - The color of the primer (Class A) shall be characteristic of the rust inhibitive pigments necessary to meet the requirements of the specifications. The color of the enamel (Class B) specified in the contract on order (see 6.2) shall match that of the standard color chip in FED. STD. 595 or Coast Guard standard as specified.

Page 2, paragraph 3.4.1.2, line 2: Delete "TT-P-422" and substitute "TT-P-442".

Page 6, paragraph 6.1: Delete and substitute - "6.1 Intended use. The coating materials covered by this specification, when used as a system, are intended for the protection of marine structures, and vessels against corrosion and exposure. They are suitable for exterior application on steel surfaces and also interior when proper safety precautions are enforced".

Paragraph 6.4, second line, Delete: "were found to be" and substitute: "are".
