This amendment forms apart of MIL-D-50030H(EA), dated 11 December 1986, and is approved for use by the U.S. Army Edgewood Research, Development and Engineering Center Department of the Army and is available for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

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2.1.1: Under "SPECIFICATIONS, MILITARY": Delete "MIL-P-51529 – Packaging of Decontaminating Agent, DS2 in 1 – 1/3 Quart Can and 5 – Gallon Pail"

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5.1: Delete in its entirety and substitute the following:

“5.1 Packaging. For acquisition purposes, the packaging requirements shall be as specified in the contract or order (see 6.2). When actual packaging of materiel is to be performed by DoD personnel, these personnel need to contact the responsible packaging activity to ascertain requisite packaging requirements. Packaging requirements are maintained by the Inventory Control Point’s packaging activity within the Military Department or Defense Agency, or within the Military Department’s System Command. Packaging data retrieval is available from the managing Military Department’s or Defense Agency’s automated packaging files, CD – ROM products, or by contacting the responsible packaging activity.”

6.2(b): Delete and substitute: “(b) Packaging requirements (including unit quantity required)(see 5.1).”
