- " 5. PACKAGING
- 5.1 <u>Preservation.</u> Preservation shall be level C or Commercial (see 6.2).
- 5.1.1. <u>Cleaning and Drying.</u> Items shall be cleaned and dried using any suitable process specified in MIL-P-116.
- 5.2 <u>Packing.</u> Packing shall be level C, or Commercial as specified (see 6.2).
- 5.2.1. <u>Assembly.</u> Assemble drums with all components in place and with the locking rings snugly applied. The bolt and nuts shall be hand tightened until snug, then rotated one-quarter turn more. (see 4.5.4.1.)
- 5.2.2. <u>Level C.</u> Packing shall be applied which affords adequate protection during shipment.
- 5.2.3. <u>Commercial.</u> All drums packed to this level must conform to requirements in ASTM D3951.
- 5.3. <u>Palletization</u>. Palletization of drums or boxes shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-147 when specified (see 6.2).
- 5.4. Marking. In addition to any other markings required by the contract or order (see 6.2), interior and exterior containers shall be marked in accordance with MIL-STD-129.
