Location, actuation, and ease and accuracy of operating all controls essential to flight operations and mission performance shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-203, MIL-STD-1472, and MIL-C-81774. Format, coding, and interpretability of displays and indicators shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-884, MIL-STD-411, and MIL-STD-1472. Legends and labels shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-783. Software for multifunction controls and/or displays shall conform to MIL-STD-1679.

Add paragraph 3.17.15 (3):

- (3) The contractor shall demonstrate the capability of the aircrew to accomplish the mission requirements designated for the aircraft. The contractor shall include demonstrations that verify task times and accuracies to be within specified performance limits.
