MILITARY SPECIFICATION

ENVIRONMENTAL TESTING, AERONAUTICAL AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT,
GENERAL SPECIFICATION FOR

This notice should be filed in front of MIL-E-5272C(ASG)
dated 13 April 1959.

1. MIL-E-5272C(ASG) is hereby made INACTIVE FOR NEW DESIGN and is used by the Air Force only in procurement of replenishment spares as necessary to maintain equipment in the field until obsolescence or wear out.
2. For new design, use MIL-STD-810 Environmental Test Methods.
3. Transition from MIL-E-5272C(ASG) to MIL-STD-810B is as follows:
