3.3.1, lines 2 and 3: Delete "dyed Olive Green 106 and shall conform to type III, class 3 of MIL-C-7219" and substitute "type III, class 5 woodland camouflage printed, or type III, class 3 dyed Olive Green 106 conforming to MIL-C-7219."

4.4.2, under "Material" for Cut parts, line 12, after class 3: Add "or class 5".

"5.2 Palletization. When specified (see 6.2), field packs, packed as specified in 5.1.2 or 5.1.3, shall be palletized on a 4-way entry pallet in accordance with load type 1A of MIL-STD-147. Pallet types shall be type I (4-way entry), type IV or type V in accordance with MIL-STD-147. Pallets shall be fabricated from wood groups I, II, III, or IV of MIL-STD-731. Each prepared load shall be bonded with primary and secondary straps in accordance with bonding means K and L or film bonding means O or P. Pallet pattern shall be number 6 in accordance with the appendix of MIL-STD-147. Interlocking of loads shall be effected by reversing the pattern of each course."
