PAGE 3

- 3.1.4, a: Delete first sentence and substitute "Iron, Nickel, Cobalt alloy (KOVAR) per MIL-I-23011, Class I, ASTM F-15.".
- 3.1.5: Delete first sentence and substitute "The lead material shall consist of Iron, Nickel, Cobalt alloy (KOVAR) per MIL-I-23011, Class I, ASTM F-15.".

PAGE 4

- 3.2.3: Add the following sentence at the end of the paragraph "Aluminum shall be used for wire bonding on substrate interconnects."

- 3.2.4: Line 2: Add "or vacuum, min 4 (10) Torr." after "atmosphere".

PAGE 10

Add "5/" after "Group I-1".

PAGE 11

Notes: Add new note "5/ Electrical rejects may be used provided their construction and processing through final seal is identical to that of the device."

PAGE 12

- * 4.4.2: Delete "Where first article testing is specified in procurement document, the quality conformance tests of 4.4.2.2 will not be performed for the first 450 pieces of product." and substitute:

"When the number of units in the first article lot exceeds the number of units required for first article testing, the balance of the first article lot (the untested units) may be used for production without quality conformance tests if the first article lot does not exceed 450 units and the contractor passes first article testing."

PAGE 14

- 4.4.2.2, minor 201: Add "2/" after "(Non-destructive)."

Note 2: Add "1," after "Groups".

PAGE 17

- 4.5.1, line 2: Delete "determine the minimum strength" and substitute "destruction".

- 4.5.1, last sentence: Delete in its entirety.
