Materials used shall be free from defects which would adversely affect the performance or maintainability of individual components or the overall assembly. Materials not specified herein shall be of the same quality used for the intended purpose in commercial practice. None of the above shall be interpreted to mean that the use of used or rebuilt products will be allowed."

5.1.2. In line 4 delete "UU-P-271 and sealed with an adhesive conforming to MIL-A-14042" and substitute "MIL-B-131 and closed in accordance with the applicable container specification."
