MILITARY SPECIFICATION  
 GRAPHITE, DRY  
 (FOR USE IN AMMUNITION)

This Amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-G-155A, dated 20 September 1962, and is mandatory for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Paragraph 2.1, under "SPECIFICATIONS-MILITARY," Delete "JAN-P-112 and JAN-T-339 in their entirety" and substitute the following:

"MIL-D-112--Drum, Plywood

MIL-T-339--Tetryl (Trinitrophenylmethylnitramine)."

Paragraph 2.1, under "STANDARDS-MILITARY", add the following:

"MIL-STD-1235--Single and Multilevel Continuous Sampling Procedures and Tables for Inspection by Attributes."

Paragraph 2.1 "Publications"--delete in its entirety.

Paragraph 4.2.2.1 Delete "JAN-T-339" and substitute "MIL-T-339"

Paragraph 4.2.4 Delete "Handbook ORD-M608-11" and substitute "MIL-STD-1235."

Paragraph 4.3.3 Determination of Silica: Delete "percent silica equals 100A" in its entirety and substitute the following:

"Percent silica equals  $\frac{100(A-C)}{B}$ "

A equals weight of residue, grams as found in paragraph 4.3.2.

C equals weight of residue, after treatment

B equals weight of specimen, grams."

Paragraph 5.1.1 Delete "JAN-D-112" and substitute "MIL-D-112."
