MILITARY SPECIFICATION  
 INSULATION TAPE, ELECTRICAL, HIGH-TEMPERATURE  
 GLASS FIBER, PRESSURE-SENSITIVE

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-I-19166C, dated 19 July 1963, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

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2.2. Delete reference to OFFICIAL CLASSIFICATION COMMITTEE and substitute:

"UNIFORM CLASSIFICATION COMMITTEE  
 Uniform Freight Classification Rules.

\*(Application for copies should be addressed to Uniform Classification Committee, Room 1106, Riverside Plaza, Chicago, Illinois 60606.)"

3.1. Delete and substitute:

"3.1 Qualification. The glass fiber, silicone adhesive, pressure-sensitive electrical insulation tape furnished under this specification shall be products which are qualified for listing on the applicable qualified products list at the time set for opening of bids. Each thickness of material will require separate qualification (see 4.2 and 6.3)."

3.4, line 4: Delete "1-inch" and substitute "3-inch".

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4.1. Delete and substitute:

"4.1 Responsibility for inspection. Unless otherwise specified in the contract, the contractor is responsible for the performance of all inspection requirements as specified herein. Except as otherwise specified in the contract, the contractor may use his own or any other facilities suitable for the performance of the inspection requirements specified herein, unless disapproved by the Government. The Government reserves the right to perform any of the inspections set forth in the specification where such inspections are deemed necessary to assure supplies and services conform to prescribed requirements."

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4.2. Delete paragraph and footnote and substitute:

"4.2 Qualification tests. Qualification tests shall be conducted at a laboratory satisfactory to the Naval Ship Engineering Center. Qualification tests shall consist of the tests specified in 4.4.2."

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Below 5. PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY, add the following parenthetical paragraph:

"(The preparation for delivery requirements specified herein apply only for direct Government procurements. For the extent of applicability of the preparation for delivery requirements of referenced documents listed in section 2, see 6.6.)"

5.1.1.1, line 2: Delete "or other suitable container" and substitute "or other suitable rigid container".

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6.3 and 6.4. Delete and substitute:

"6.3 With respect to products requiring qualification, awards will be made only for products which are at the time set for opening of bids, qualified for inclusion in applicable Qualified Products List QPL-19166 whether or not such products have actually been so

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listed by that date. The attention of the contractors is called to these requirements, and manufacturers are urged to arrange to have the products that they propose to offer to the Federal Government tested for qualification in order that they may be eligible to be awarded contracts or orders for the products covered by this specification. The activity responsible for the Qualified Products List is the Naval Ship Engineering Center, Prince George's Center, Center Building, Hyattsville, Maryland 20782, and information pertaining to qualification of products may be obtained from that activity. Application for Qualification tests shall be made in accordance with "Provisions Governing Qualification SD-6" (see 6.4)."

"6.4 Copies of "Provisions Governing Qualification SD-6" may be obtained upon application to Commanding Officer, Naval Publications and Forms Center, 5801 Tabor Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19120."

6.5, Delete and substitute:

"6.5 Certain provisions of this specification are the subject of international standardization agreement ABC-NAVY-STD-17. When amendment, revision, or cancellation of this specification is proposed which will affect or violate the international agreement concerned, the preparing activity will take appropriate reconciliation action through international standardization channels including departmental standardization offices, if required."

Add the following new paragraph:

"6.6 Sub-contracted material and parts. The preparation for delivery requirements of referenced documents listed in section 2 do not apply when material and parts are procured by the contractor for incorporation into the equipment and lose their separate identity when the equipment is shipped."
