"3.3.1 Analysis. The specific material supplied shall be analyzed for the following
leachable ions: (1) chloride, (2) sodium or silicate (if necessary to meet the accept-
ance requirement of figure 1, both sodium and silicate should be analyzed). The "plot
point" of these analyses shall fall in the acceptable area of figure 1. The minimum
allowable value of sodium and silicate shall be 100 ppm."
