INSULATION TAPE, ELECTRICAL, SELF-FUSING:

FOR USE IN MERCIRONIC, COMMUNICATIONS,

AND ALLIED EQUIPMENT

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-I-3825B, 21 May 1965, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Page 3. Paragraph 3.4 is changed to read as follows:

"3.4 Specific gravity. When tape is tested as specified in 4.3.3, the maximum value shall be 1.204 at $23/23^{\circ}C$."

Paragraph 3.7 is changed to read as follows:

* "3.7 Marking. Unless otherwise specified, the month & year of manufacture shall be marked on the inside diameter of the tape core. Other pertinent information including the MIL Specification number, dimensions, thickness, etc. shall be printed on the carton of a label affixed to the unit pack.

Page 11. Add the following paragraph:

"6.3 International standardization agreement. Certain provisions of this specification are the subject of international standardization agreement ABC-NAVY-STD-17C. When amendment, revision, or cancellation of this specification is proposed which will affect or violate the international agreement concerned, the preparing activity will take appropriate reconciliation action through international standardization channels including departmental standardization.
