Under Military Standards: Delete "MIL-STD-1188 - Commercial Packaging of Supplies and Equipment" and add "MIL-STD-147 - Palletized Unit Loads" and "MIL-STD-731 - Quality of Wood Members for Containers and Pallets."

Add new paragraphs:

"2.2 Other publications. The following documents form a part of this document to the extent specified herein. Unless otherwise specified, the issues of the documents which are DOD adopted shall be those listed in the issue of the DODISS specified in the solicitation. Unless otherwise specified, the issues of documents not listed in the DODISS shall be the issues of the nongovernment documents which are current on the date of the solicitation.

Add new paragraph:

"4.2.4 Palletization examination. The fully packaged and palletized end items shall be examined for the defects listed below. The lot size shall be expressed in units of palletized unit loads. The sample unit shall be one palletized unit load, fully packaged. The inspection level shall be S-1 and the AQL, expressed in terms of defects per hundred units, shall be 6.5.

Finished dimensions	Length, width, or height exceeds specified maximum requirement.
Palletization	Pallet pattern not as specified. Interlocking of loads not as specified. Load not bonded as specified.
Weight	Exceeds maximum load limits.
Marking	Omitted; incorrect; illegible; of improper size location, sequence, or method of application."

5.2.1, line 10: Delete "type I, grade B of UU-P-268" and substitute "A-A-203".

At the end of the paragraph: Add "Shipping containers shall be arranged in unit loads in accordance with MIL-L-35078 for the type and class of load specified (see 6.2). Strapping shall be limited to nonmetallic strapping, except for type II, class F loads."

- 5.2.2, line 10: Delete "type I, grade B of UU-P-268" and substitute "A-A-203".
- 5.2.3: Delete "MIL-STD-1188" and substitute "ASTM D 3951".
- 5.3: Delete and substitute:
- "5.3 Marking. In addition to special marking required by the contract or purchase order, unit packs, shipping containers and palletized unit loads shall be marked in accordance with MIL-STD-129 or ASTM D 3951, as applicable."

Line 5: Delete "sizes" and substitute "NSN's".

Add new paragraph:

- "5.4 <u>Palletization</u>. When specified (see 6.2), liners, packed as specified in 5.2.2 and 5.2.3 shall be palletized on a 4-way entry pallet in accordance with load type Ia of MIL-STD-147. Pallet types shall be type I (4-way entry), type IV, or type V in accordance with MIL-STD-147. Pallets shall be fabricated from wood groups I, II, III, or IV of MIL-STD-731. Each prepared load shall be bonded with primary and secondary straps in accordance with bonding means K and L or film bonding means O or P. Pallet pattern shall be number 3 in accordance with the appendix of MIL-STD-147. Interlocking of loads shall be effected by reversing the pattern of each course."
- 6.2 Ordering data: Add "e. Type and class of unit load required (see 5.2.1).
