MILITARY SPECIFICATION

LUBRICANT, WEAPONS, SEMI-FLUID
(HIGH LOAD-CARRYING CAPACITY)

This Amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-L-46150, dated 15 April 1971, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

PAGE 1

2.1, SPECIFICATIONS, FEDERAL: Delete reference to "L-P-403-Plastic Molding Material, Polytetrafluoroethylene (TFE-Fluorocarbon)"

STANDARDS, FEDERAL: Add reference to "FED-STD-313 - Material Safety Data Sheets Preparation And Submission Of".

PAGE 2

2.2, Delete reference to "D 270 - Sampling Petroleum and Petroleum Products". Add the following to listing of ASTMs:

"D 4057 - Manual Sampling of Petroleum Products
D 4177 - Automatic Sampling of Petroleum
and Petroleum Products"

PAGE 3

3.1, Last sentence. Delete "L-P-403, type IV, class (see 6.4a)" and substitute in place "ASTM D 1457, Type IV".

PAGE 4

Add A New Paragraph "3.3.6" As Follows: "3.3.6 Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS). A MSDS Shall Be Prepared In Accordance With FED-STD-313 (See 4.6.5 & 6.6)"

PAGE 9

Add A New Paragraph "4.6.5" As Follows: "4.6.5 MSDS. Verify That An MSDS Has Been Prepared In Accordance With FED-STD-313".

PAGE 10

6.3, Last sentence. Delete "Hq., U.S. Army Weapons Command, ATTN: AMSWE-RET-ML, Rock Island, Illinois 61201" and substitute in place "Commander, ARDEC, ATTN: SMCAR-ESC-S, Dover, NJ 07801-5001".

6.4, Delete content of subparagraph "a." entirely.

Add a new paragraph "6.6" as follows:

"6.6 Material safety data sheets. Contracting officers will identify those activities requiring copies of completed Material Safety Data Sheets prepared in accordance with FED-STD-313. The pertinent Government mailing addresses for submission of data are listed in Appendix B of FED-STD-313."
