

MIL-L-757A
AMENDMENT 1
27 September 1968

MILITARY SPECIFICATION

LEAD STYPHNATE, NORMAL

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-L-757A, dated 1 September 1967, and is mandatory for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Page 2, par. 3.1. Delete and substitute:

"3.1 Appearance. The material shall be free from visible impurities and free from aggregates which are larger than the maximum allowable crystal dimensions permitted under par. 3.3."

Page 2, par. 3.2. Delete and substitute:

"3.2 Crystal form. The material shall be crystalline and the longest dimension of any crystal shall not be greater than three times the next longest axis. Hexagonal plates are acceptable."

Page 4, par. 4.5.2. Delete and substitute:

"4.5.2 Appearance. Take four portions of about 0.5 mg. each from different places in the dry sample and spread them over an area of about 2 sq. cm. on a glass microscopic slide. Examine the material macroscopically for impurities under daylight illumination and microscopically for impurities and aggregates of crystals using a magnification of about 30 times and reflected light."
